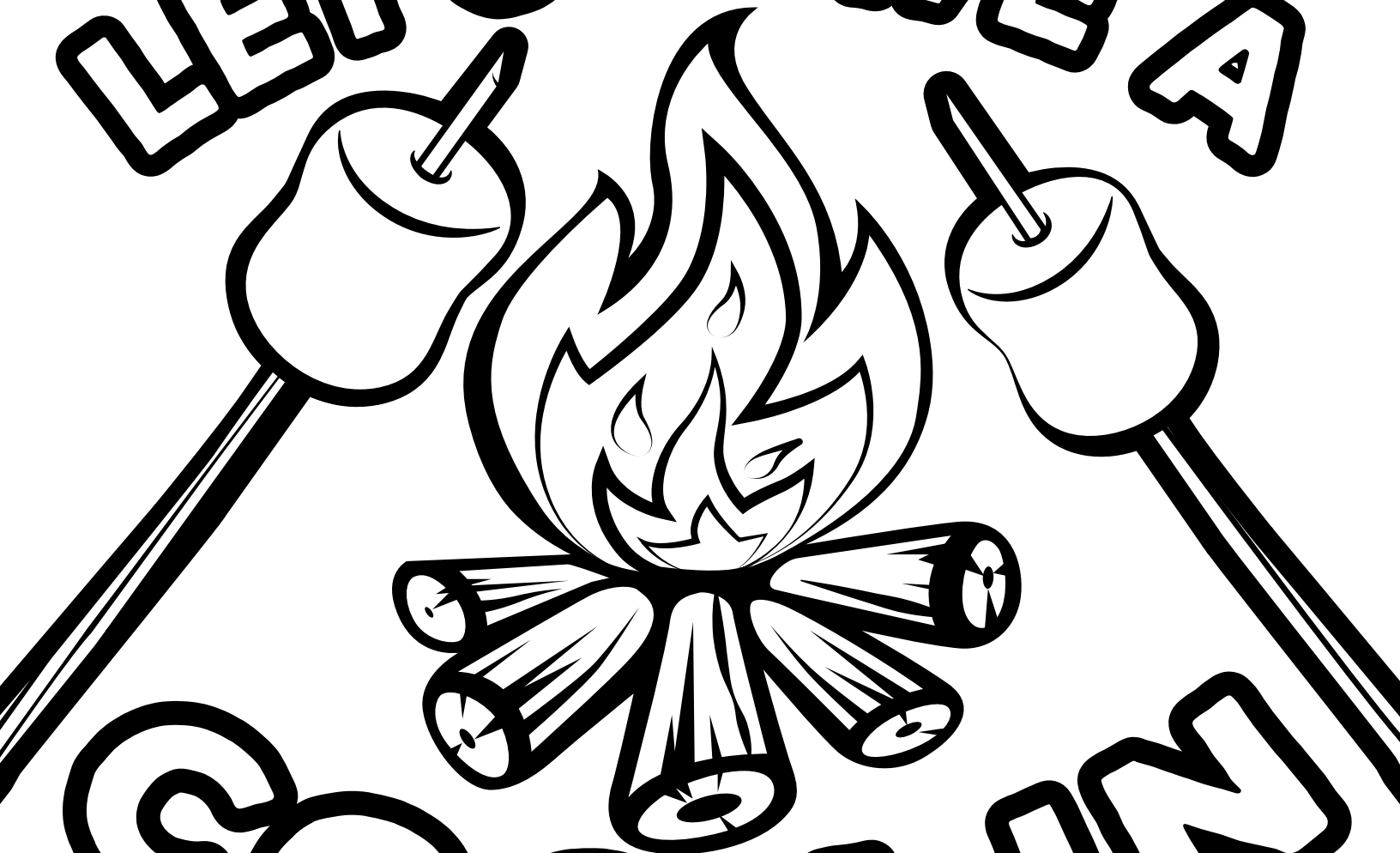

COOKING

DIY FAUX FIRE PIT:

Materials for Campfire Craft

1. Clear disposable cup
2. Yellow tissue paper (include orange and red tissue for added fire effect)
3. Scissors
4. LED tea candle
5. Stick from outdoors OR popsicle sticks
6. Cotton balls
7. Brown construction paper OR empty toilet paper rolls
8. Craft glue

Instructions

Cut colored tissue paper into 2-inch squares.

Crumple tissue paper into multiple loose balls. Glue the tissue balls to the outside of your clear plastic cup so that the edges of the tissue flare out like a flame. Continue until the cup is completely covered. Have fun with it! Swap out tissue paper colors and spacing to make it look even more like fire.

Set your fire cup aside, upside down, and allow the glue to completely dry.

A campfire isn't complete without marshmallows on a stick! Glue a cotton ball to the end of your sticks and let dry.

To create your campfire logs, cut brown construction paper into strips. Customize the look and detail of your "logs" with a brown crayon to mimic the look of tree bark. (Or decorate empty toilet paper rolls for a 3-D log effect)

It's time to build your campfire! Turn on the LED tea light and place your fire cup over it. Gather your logs and lay them around your fire. Then sit back and toast some marshmallows!
